VCCA Anniversary Badge Program

Original Notice October, 2019-Revised June, 2023

By policy, the VCCA has provided, without cost, distinctive name badges to members with 25, 35, 45 and 50 years of continuous membership. A database is maintained and badges had been automatically mailed to eligible members.

The VCCA Board of Directors revised this program. Beginning in 2018 and **going forward**, a new ten-year badge was added. The ten-year award is not retroactive. Members who joined in or after 2008 will be eligible for the new badge, without cost. Members who joined prior to 2008 will be permitted to purchase ten-year badges. Any member can search our Club database on the

website (VCCA.Org) to verify their own membership longevity.

Also, due to increasing postage rates, **all** badges will now be issued only upon request. This will help confirm mailing addresses and should reduce program expenses by eliminating unnecessary mailings. Badges requested are sent without cost to members.

Replacements for lost or damaged badges continue to be available, upon request, at cost.

Use the contact information below to request anniversary badges or for replacement/lost anniversary badges. Ten-year badges (members who joined before 2008), and any lost or damaged badges are available for \$6.00 for one badge or \$8.00 for two badges.

Pictured is an old plank road once used to cross the Mojave Desert and Sonoran Desert between the Colorado River near Parker, Arizona west to Desert Center, California. This photo was featured in a November 1935 Arizona Highways article regarding the Colorado River Aqueduct Road in the Sonoran Desert.

The Colorado River Aqueduct Road was constructed over a 242-mile corridor from Parker Dam on the Colorado River west to Lake Mathews near Corona. The Aqueduct Road broke ground Aqueduct during January 1933 near Thousand Palms and was made fully functional on January 7, 1939. During 1970 part of the Aqueduct Road was incorporated into California State Route 62 which was followed by another segment becoming California State Route 177 in 1972. Another notable portion of the Aqueduct Road also exists in modern times as Dillon Road in Coachella Valley.
