The first 235 CID engine was only offered in trucks in late 1940 for the 1941 model year. This engine had a displacement of 235.2 cubic inches and was available for all 1-1/2 Ton & COE truck models. The items that were changed from the 216 CID version were: Cylinder block, pistons, rings, connecting rods, crankshaft, camshaft, tappets, push rods and oil pan.
